## SMALL ORLANDO

The small Orlando cast iron stove has features which include top or rear flue outlets, riddling multifuel grate and airwash secondary air clean burn technology. Pictured here with the Greek 66" micro-marble surround and a fire chamber that is lined with reeded Tekniform vermiculite panels which absorb less heat than traditional masonry meaning that more heat is directed back into the room.
